

Milledgeville City Council
Called Work Session
City Hall – Executive Chambers

January 23, 2018

Milledgeville City Council met in a called work session on January 23, 2018 at 5:15 PM in the Executive Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Mary Parham–Copelan presiding. Members of Council present were Steve Chambers, Jeanette Walden, Collinda J. Lee, Denese Shinholster and Richard Mullins. Councilman Walter Reynolds was absent.

Mayor Parham–Copelan called the meeting to order at 5:28 PM. The Clerk called roll and a quorum of members of Council was declared present.

Mayor Parham–Copelan stated that the purpose of this meeting was to discuss a grant possibility and to go into closed session to discuss pending litigation.

City Manager Barry Jarrett discussed the possibility of the City applying for a grant on behalf of the Old Capital Museum Society. Mr. Jarrett recommended that the City of Milledgeville authorize the application.

There was a brief discussion about the grant and the fact that the City would be the applicant but bear no financial responsibility for funding the grant match.

Barry Jarrett recognized Frank Baugh who discussed the Department of Transportation LMIG grant for paving 8 miles of City streets and 3 miles of Central State Hospital street. Mr. Baugh stated once approved the project would get underway this quarter.

There was a brief discussion as to if the company selected to do the resurfacing. Mr. Baugh stated that they were vetted through the Department of Transportation.

Motion Mrs. Walden, second Dr. Lee to go into closed session to discuss pending litigation.

On vote aye: Mr. Chambers, Mrs. Walden, Dr. Lee, Ms. Shinholster and Mr. Mullins. The motion carried and Council went into closed session at 5:31 PM and returned to open session at 6:26 PM. Upon returning to open session, the



Mayor Parham-Copelan stated that no action was taken in closed session.


Motion Dr. Lee, second Mrs. Walden to adjourn.
