Milledgeville City Council met in a regularly scheduled work session on November 13, 2018 at 5:00 PM in the Executive Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Mary Parham-Copelan presiding. Members of Council present were Walter Reynolds, Jeanette Walden, Collinda J. Lee, Denese Shinholster, Richard Mullins and Steve Chambers.

Others present were Barry Jarrett, Jimmy Jordan and Bo Danuser.

Mayor Parham-Copelan called the meeting to order at 5:24 PM. The Clerk called roll and a quorum of members of Council was declared present.


Barry Jarrett was recognized and gave a City Manager's report. He discussed a resolution as a result of a recommendation that came out of the Risk Management meeting whereby the designated Risk Manager would be authorized to resolve insurance claims of \$10,000 or less with approval of the City Manager and Council notification of details of the settlement. City Attorney Jimmy Jordan stated that this had been discussed in the past, but no action had ever been taken. He further stated that they have had a few claims that could have been resolve rather quickly with this in place.

There was a discussion about settling insurance claims, in particular workers comp claims, and the length of time it took to settle claims.

Motion Mrs. Walden, second Mr. Reynolds to go into closed session to discuss pending litigation and a land transaction.

On vote aye: Mr. Reynolds, Mrs. Walden, Dr. Lee, Ms. Shinholster, Mr. Mullins and Mr. Chambers. The motion carried and council went into closed session at 5:46 PM and returned to open session at 6:32 PM. Upon returning to open session, the Mayor called the open portion of the meeting back order and the Clerk called roll with Councilmembers Reynolds, Walden, Lee, Shinholster, Mullins and Chambers present.

Mayor Parham-Copelan adjourned the meeting at 6:32 and Council went into the regular Council Meeting.
