Milledgeville City Council met in a called work session on Tuesday, April 24, 2018 at 5:30 PM in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Mary Parham-Copelan presiding. Members of Council present were Steve Chambers, Collinda J. Lee, Richard Mullins, Walter Reynolds, Jeanette Walden and Denese Shinholster.

Mayor Parham-Copelan called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM. The Clerk called roll and a quorum of members of Council was declared present.

Mayor Parham-Copelan recognized Barry Jarrett for his City Manager's Report. Mr. Jarrett in turn recognized Brian Renko.

Brian Renko, Executive Director of Allied Arts addressed Council to give an update on the activities of Allied Arts. Mr. Renko gave a power point presentation (Exhibit A) outlining the services Allied Arts provided to the community and the financial and cultural impact an arts program had in Milledgeville.


Mr. Jarrett recognized Matt Poyner, Executive Director of the Development Authority of the City of Milledgeville and Baldwin County for a 2018 first quarter update. Mr. Poyner discussed the Authority working with existing businesses to maintain their productivity and meeting with prospective businesses. Mr. Poyner also discussed road improvements in the industrial park, hunting and trespassing on industrial park land and the steps being taken to correct the problem, the need for an Economic Impact Study and finally he discussed the Fall Line Development Authority's multi-county efforts for the industrial park located on the south side of Baldwin County. Mr. Poyner answered a few questions.

City Manager Barry Jarrett presented Council members with a proposed fiscal year 2019 annual operating budget and stated the proposed budget would be available to the public in the morning.
