

Milledgeville City Council Meeting

Milledgeville City Council met in a regular session on Tuesday, August 28, 2018 at 6:30 PM in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Mary Parham-Copelan presiding. Members of Council present were Collinda J. Lee, Denese Shinholster, Richard Mullins, Jeanette Walden, Walter Reynolds and Steve Chambers.

Others present were Cedric Davis, Bo Danuser, Melba Hilson-Butts, Billy Hobbs and Chris McKearney.

Mayor Parham-Copelan called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. The Clerk called roll and a quorum of members of Council was declared present.

Mayor Parham-Copelan said a prayer and then led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion Ms. Shinholster, second Mrs. Walden to adopt the August 14, 2018 Council meeting minutes.

On vote aye: Dr. Lee, Mrs. Shinholster, Mr. Mullins, Mrs. Walden, Mr. Reynolds and Mr. Chambers. The motion carried and the minutes were adopted as official.

Mayor Parham-Copelan stated that there was no old business and moved to new business.

Mayor Parham-Copelan stated that at the request of the City Manager, Resolution R-1808-042 was being removed from the agenda.

Motion Mr. Reynolds, second Mr. Mullins to amend the agenda to add Resolution R-1808-043 and an appointment to the Historic Preservation Commission to the agenda.

On vote aye: Dr. Lee, Ms. Shinholster, Mr. Mullins, Mrs. Walden, Mr. Reynolds and Mr. Chambers. The motion carried and the agenda was amended.

The Clerk read Resolution R-1808-043 by caption stating that this resolution authorized an Intergovernmental Agreement with Baldwin County Board of

Commissioners regarding the use of voluntary alternative dispute resolution to review and revise the existing Service Delivery Strategy.

The resolution was presented as follows:

A Resolution to Authorize and Intergovernmental Agreement with Baldwin County Board of Commissioners Regarding the Use of Voluntary Alternative Dispute Resolution to Review and Revise the Existing Service Delivery Strategy

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Milledgeville desire to enter into an agreement with the Baldwin County Board of Commissioners regarding the use of voluntary alternative dispute resolution to review and revise the existing Service Delivery Strategy; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned agreement is hereby attached and by reference duly incorporated and made a part of this resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Milledgeville, meeting in formal session, that Mayor Mary Parham-Copelan is hereby authorized to enter into the attached agreement on behalf of the City of Milledgeville with the Baldwin County Board of Commissioners regarding the use of voluntary alternative dispute resolution to review and revise the existing service delivery strategy.

On vote aye: Dr. Lee, Ms. Shinholster, Mr. Mullins, Mrs. Walden, Mr. Reynolds and Mr. Chambers. The motion carried and Mr. Baymon was reappointed to the Historic Preservation Commission.

The Clerk presented an alcoholic beverage license application for Catherine C. Wooten on behalf of Octagon Extreme Café located at 2400 North Columbia Street for beer, wine and Sunday sales – consumption on premises.

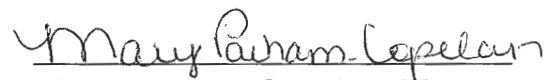
Motion Mr. Mullins, second Mr. Reynolds to approve the license as presented.
