***In the evolving pandemic, the Interim City manager may modify allowances related to Essential Businesses. Even for Essential Businesses, compliance with the Social Distancing Requirements of the Resolution is required and expected.***

**“Businesses” includes for-profit, non-profit, and private educational institutions.**

**Not Considered Essential-** *ordered to close and remain closed, effective March 26, 2020 at 12:00am and continue during the effective time of this Resolution.*

## **Essential Businesses**

***Social distancing is required, meaning: maintaining at least six-foot social distancing from other individuals, washing hands with soap and water for at least twenty seconds as frequently as possible or using hand sanitizer, covering coughs or sneezes (into the sleeve or elbow, not hands), regularly cleaning high-touch surfaces and not shaking hands.***

- Healthcare Operations (hospitals, clinics, doctors, dentists, pharmacies, pharmaceutical & biotechnology companies, other healthcare facilities, healthcare suppliers, home healthcare services providers, mental health providers, vision services, dermatology, veterinary services, etc.)
- Home Services (services that allow for the safe and clean operation of homes and businesses)
- Home-based Personal Care (for adults,

children, pets, or seniors)

- HVAC (Heating/Cooling) Contractors
- Infrastructure (public works construction, construction and all related activities, airport operations, water, sewer, gas, electrical, oil refining, roads and highways, public transportation, solid waste collection and removal, internet, and telecommunications systems)
